Bloom:	Unique branching triangular flower spikes with large individual blooms in warm apricot tones.
Bloom Period:	Long blooming period. Early spring– fall.
Foliage:	Glossy rich green foliage.
Habit:	Unique erect bushy habit. 12” x 12”.
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
Additional Comments:	Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching. Trim back & feed to encourage strong re-blooming.
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.

4.5” Quarts:	6-8 weeks from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).
6” Gallons:	10-12 weeks from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).
