Culture:	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.	
Additional Comments:	Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching. Trim back & feed to encourage	
	strong re-blooming.	
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.
