Genus & Species:	<i>Alonsoa meridionalis</i>
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted.
USDA Zone:	Zone 9. (25°F or -6°C).
Bloom:	Soft pink blooms contrasting well with the elegant variegated foliage.
Bloom Time:	Early summer - fall. (Long Blooming Season).
Foliage:	Elegant soft gold & green variegated foliage.
Habit:	Tight compact habit with close internodes. Ultimately 24" x 24".
Propagation:	Tip cuttings or Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in full sun in rich well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Pinch when young & after blooming to encourage strong basal branching & re-blooming. Heat & drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Pots & Containers, Garden Border, Modern landscape.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" Quarts:	6-8 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring planting).
6" Gallons:	10-12 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring planting).
