<b>Culture:</b>	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching. Trim back & feed to encourage strong re-blooming.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.

<b>4.5" Quarts:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks</b> from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).
<b>6" Gallons:</b>	<b>10-12 weeks</b> from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).
