Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Diascia hybrida</i> .
Protection Status:	EU – 10,170. USA – Good Faith Royalty.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 9. (20°F or -6°C).
Bloom:	Large soft pink flowers.
Bloom Period:	Long blooming period. Early spring– fall.
Foliage:	Small fresh green foliage.
Habit:	Compact rounded habit. 10" x 12".
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
Additional Comments:	Excellent cool season crops. Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching. Trim back & feed to encourage strong re-blooming.
Uses:	Containers, Baskets, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" Quarts:	6-8 weeks from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).
6" Gallons:	10-12 weeks from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).
